# REPORT ON THE STATUS OF THE BUSINESS RESCUE PROCEEDINGS OF TONGAAT HULETT LIMITED (IN BUSINESS RESCUE) ("COMPANY" OR "THL")

#### 1. GENERAL

- 1.1. In accordance with section 132(3)(a) and section 132(3)(b) of the Companies Act 71 of 2008, as amended ("Companies Act"), when the business rescue proceedings of a company have not concluded within 3 months of the date on which they started, a business rescue practitioner is required to -
  - 1.1.1. prepare a report on the progress of the business rescue, and update it at the end of each subsequent month until the end of the business rescue proceedings; and
  - 1.1.2. deliver the report and each update to each affected person and to the Companies and Intellectual Property Commission ("CIPC").
- 1.2. In compliance with the sections referred to in paragraph 1.1 above, we hereby provide you with the eighteenth report, being the June 2024 report, on the status of the Company's business rescue proceedings.



#### 2. BUSINESS RESCUE UPDATES

The following matters have occurred or remain relevant since the distribution and publication of the Company's May 2024 business rescue status update report ("May Report"):

#### 2.1. Implementation of the Adopted Amended Business Rescue Plan

- 2.1.1. The business rescue practitioners ("BRPs") continue to advance the preparatory steps for the implementation of the Adopted and Amended Business Rescue Plan ("the Plan") for THL as approved and adopted by the requisite majority of creditors on Thursday 11 January 2024 in accordance with section 151 of the Companies Act.
- 2.1.2. The Vision parties ("Vision"), the IDC, management of the Company and the BRPs, ("the Parties") are continuing to take the necessary steps to satisfy all conditions on which the Plan is contingent, aimed at ensuring the successful implementation of the Plan. Preparation for and submissions to the required regulatory processes and approvals is continuing and nearing finality.
- 2.1.3. Substantial progress has been made with regard to the implementation of the Plan and the Vision transaction. To give effect to the recapitalisation contemplated in the Plan, the Competition Commission in South Africa has recommended that the transaction be approved by the Competition Tribunal. The outcome of the Competition Tribunal decision in this regard is expected imminently. The Botswana competition filing was submitted in late June, with the Zimbabwe and Mozambique filings expected to be submitted shortly.
- 2.1.4. A circular to shareholders, in relation to the share subscription (i.e. exchange of debt for shares) detailed in the Plan, is expected to be disseminated shortly.
- 2.1.5. As detailed in the April report, the IDC's existing Post Commencement Finance facility has been extended to 21 August 2024. The BRPs are in negotiations with the IDC for a further extension.
- 2.1.6. Vision continues to cooperate fully with the BRPs and executive management of the Company to bring implementation of the transaction to a close as soon as possible. There is a core team focused on satisfying the conditions on which the Plan is contingent and



ensuring the implementation of the underlying transaction.

#### 2.2. Business Rescue Proceedings of other Tongaat Hulett Group Entities

- 2.2.1. The approved and adopted business rescue plan for Tongaat Hulett Developments Proprietary Limited ("THD") as published on Friday, 19 May 2023 continues to be implemented.
- 2.2.2. The BRPs also continue to advance the preparatory steps for the implementation of the Adopted and Amended Business Rescue Plans of both Tongaat Hulett Sugar South Africa Proprietary Limited (in business rescue) ("THSSA") and Voermol Feeds Proprietary Limited (in business rescue) ("Voermol") as approved and adopted by the requisite majority of creditors on Wednesday 31 January 2024 in accordance with section 151 of the Companies Act.
- 2.2.3. Separate monthly status update reports are provided for THD, THSSA and Voermol, which reports are uploaded and made accessible to Affected Persons on the Company's website at: <a href="http://www.tongaat.com">http://www.tongaat.com</a>, under the 'Business Rescue' tab.

### 2.3. Litigation Matters

- 2.3.1. Declarator Application: Vahed J ruled against THL and the BRPs in respect of THL's application for declaratory relief under case number D4472/23 (see notice to affected persons dated 5 December 2023). THL and the BRPs applied for leave to appeal the judgement, which application was heard on 20 March 2024 and on 6 May 2024 Vahed J refused the leave to appeal with costs. On 6 June 2024, the Company and the BRPs lodged a Petition for leave to appeal the judgment of Vahed J in the Supreme Court of Appeal in Bloemfontein ("the Petition"). The respondents' answering affidavits in the Petition are due on 3 July 2024. Full details of the Petition are set out in the BRPs' notice to Affected Persons dated 3 June 2024, and a copy of the Petition is available for download at <a href="https://www.tongaat.com/business-rescue/">https://www.tongaat.com/business-rescue/</a>.
- 2.3.2. **Powertrans Application:** With regard to the application brought by Mohini Singari Naidoo trading as Powertrans Sales & Services ("**Powertrans**") under case number D3902/2024



(see notice to affected persons dated 11 April 2024) to declare the Plan unlawful and set the Plan aside, the Company and the BRPs have opposed this application, and served their answering affidavit on 20 May 2024. The Vision parties have also opposed the application and filed their answering affidavit. Powertrans had 10 Court Days thereafter to file their replying affidavit(s), which time has lapsed. On filing their replying affidavit(s), Powertrans will be required to apply for condonation for the late filing thereof. In addition, Powertrans have sought discovery of numerous additional documents from both the Vision parties and the Company, which the Company considers to be nothing more than a fishing expedition, and many of the documents sought are not relevant to an adjudication of the application. Accordingly, both the Vision parties and the Company have refused to provide the additional documents. A hearing date for this application has not been allocated at this stage.

#### 2.4. Creditor Claims

- 2.4.1. Creditors are reminded to review their claims as they are reflected in 'Annexure A' of the Plan, which reflects all claims in accordance with the Company's records. - 2.4.2. Take note that the Plan provides a process for Creditors to deal with any remaining disputes related to claims, and Creditors who dispute their claims reflected in the Plan, will be at liberty to follow such process, if they so wish.

#### 3. CLOSING REMARKS

- 3.1. It remains our view that the Company stands a reasonable prospect of being rescued, as contemplated in section 128(1)(h) of the Companies Act, in a manner that will balance the rights and interests of all Affected Persons.
- 3.2.
